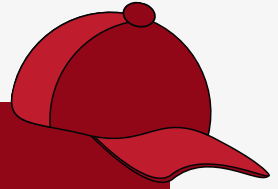

Rules and Regulations

1.1 Pheasant Run memberships provide a member with the right to use the club's facilities available to that category of membership upon payment of applicable fees, pursuant to and in accordance with the membership plan, by-laws, rules and regulations established for the club. It does not provide a member with any ownership or equitable interest in the club or the facility or other assets owned by the club.

1.2 Pheasant Run shall use all reasonable efforts to have the club's golf course available to playing members during the golfing season. The closure of all or any portion of the club for repair, maintenance, improvement, corporate events or expansion and the use of all or any portion of the club for the purpose of private functions, corporate events, or otherwise shall be permitted at the sole discretion of the club.

1.3 Pheasant Run shall have the right, in its absolute discretion, to accept or reject any application for membership. Pheasant Run shall not be required to provide reasons for its decision to accept or reject an application for membership. Pheasant Run may establish such order of priorities for consideration and acceptance of applications as it determines to be appropriate.

1.4 Pheasant Run shall not be responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged items associated with club cleaning.

1.5 All members will be required to fill out a general liability waiver and cart waiver prior to the 2026 golf season.

Code of Conduct

The Code of Conduct has been developed to ensure a safe, friendly and respectful place for all members, guests and staff. As a member, you will be held to the highest standard and are expected to be an example to other guests and patrons of Pheasant Run Golf Club.

The Code of Conduct differs from rules in that it addresses acceptable/unacceptable behavior as well as expectations of members and Red Hat Club members.

All Members and Red Hat Club Members Club are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that:

- Creates an environment and culture that reflects honesty, integrity and good sportsmanship.
- Is free of discrimination or any form of harassing behaviour including sexual harassment toward other members, guests, and staff.
- Acknowledges Pheasant Run Golf Club as a family friendly environment and, therefore, refrains from using obscenities and loud boisterous behaviour inappropriate for children and respectable taste.

All members and Red Hat Club members acknowledge and agree:

- Hitting a golf ball in the direction of any other member, guest or staff is completely unacceptable and will result in the most severe of disciplinary action.
- To observe proper etiquette on and off the course. Proper etiquette includes, but is not limited to:
 - Repairing all pitch marks on the greens
 - Replacing all divots
 - Refrain from any intentional abuse of the golf course or facilities.
 - Meet the minimum pace of play requirement at all times.
 - Follow all directions given by the starter and on-course staff.
 - Behave in a way that does not disrupt the enjoyment of other members and patrons.
- That the Club Management is responsible for instructing the staff in the performance of their duties and that members and guests have no authority to direct staff.
- To adhere to all Pheasant Run Golf Club rules and policies, including the club Alcohol policy.
- That all members and Red Hat members must check-in and register with the pro shop prior to play.
- To follow all safe operation and on-course use of power cart directives, including adherence to directives outlining areas where usage is prohibited.

Any member or Red Hat member that violates the above code of conduct may face disciplinary action at the sole discretion of the General Manager, up to and including the suspension and or loss of membership privileges.

Rental Equipment and Power Carts

In renting Pheasant Run equipment, I hereby agree to assume full responsibility and liability for any damage done to or by our equipment to be charged to me – including injury to myself or other persons while it is in my possession and to absolve and indemnify Pheasant Golf Inc./Pheasant Run Golf Club completely there from. If the above is not adhered to, I also agree to forfeit the equipment without a refund.

Power carts can cause bodily harm or death to the driver, passenger and/or bystanders. Power cart drivers must be 21 years of age or older.

The member will acknowledge that there are risks inherent in participating in the game of golf. The member agrees to release the club from any liability from personal injury, property damage or loss sustained by the Member, including injury resulting in death and any financial loss or damage, directly or indirectly resulting from the Member's activities or participation in events at the club. The member further waives, as against the club, all claims recourse and rights of action that the Member might have against Pheasant Run Golf Club as a result of such personal injury, property damage or loss.

I understand that Pheasant Run Golf Club may cancel my membership at any time during the season. There are no refunds on memberships and they are non-transferable.

Memberships are not to be combined with any coupon or promotion.

Alcohol and Gaming policy

As per the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario Members and guests are not allowed to bring their own alcohol on to Pheasant Run Golf Club property, this includes the golf course, parking lot, and clubhouse. Alcohol purchased at Pheasant Run is not allowed off of the property. The member also agrees to provide a photo which will enable staff to confirm identity.

Member Booking / Cancellation Policy

All member bookings will be taken online only, with the exception of Singles. Singles may book through the Proshop only on the day of play or one day before play, or in advance by booking with a twosome or threesome, where space is available.

Please note, a credit card must be provided to secure member tee times.

24 hours notice or more: All member bookings can be canceled or reduced in the number of players with 24 hours notice or more without any charge.

Less than 24 hours notice: Cancellation, no-show, or reduction of the number of players in the original tee time with less than 24 hours notice will result in the credit card on file to be charged at the RedHat rate. All member types will face the same charges. These charges are final and cannot be used for credit to future bookings.
